SCHEDULE CHANGES

We have been trying to keep up with any and all schedule change needs as they came in June, July, and August. At this point, students really should have a solid schedule. If this is not the case, the deadline for any changes is August 18 by 3pm.

ATHLETIC PASSES

CHROMEBOOK DISTRIBUTION

PLEASE **DO NOT** INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Double images or collage style photos
- Props
- Shots that include hands on face
- Picture with sunglasses or hats that cover the face
- Selfies or photos of students laying down
- Student name or year
- Studio name or website
- **No Screenshots!!!**
